About this training

- Designed for users with advanced content authoring permissions (or with the roles OC Power Publishers, OC System Administrators and OC Site Managers).
- The purpose of the training is to give you a step-by-step introduction to OpenCities with a focus on completing end-to-end content publishing.

Before the training

- Ensure attendees have access to your OpenCities admin to follow your trainer's demonstration.
- The training is run remotely on Microsoft Teams. To ensure the training runs smoothly, we recommend joining the meeting on your PC with a connected headset. Attending the training session with dual monitors works best to follow the trainer's demonstrations.
- You can hold the training session in a conference room on a projector/big screen. If you do, please ensure that you can connect the device you will be using with clear audio and video prior to the training.
